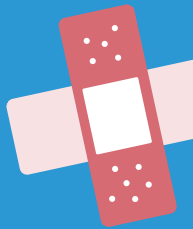
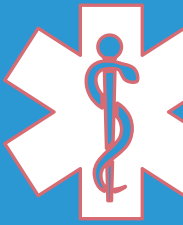




VOTER VITALS: A HEALTH CARE TRACKING POLL

The fourth edition of Voter Vitals shows that health care remains one of the most important issues in the 2020 presidential election. During this critical time, the vast majority of voters prefer to build on our current health care system rather than create the public option. In fact, most voters are unwilling to pay any more in taxes or health care costs to create the public option.

HEALTH CARE POLICY

- Lowering **COSTS** (66%) is the top health care priority for Democratic, Swing, and Republican voters.
- More voters support **FIXING what we have today** (66% support) than the public option (49% support) and Medicare for All (42% support).
- 65% of voters would rather **BUILD ON** our current health care system than create the public option (35%).
- 79% of voters with health insurance coverage are **SATISFIED** with their coverage.
- 68% of voters are **UNWILLING** to pay any more for health care and 65% are **UNWILLING** to pay any more in taxes to create the public option.
- 63% of voters believe **PRIVATE COVERAGE** should continue to exist and have a role in our health care system.
